A Message from League Coordinators

As the 2009 tennis season kicks off we wanted to thank all of the League Captains for putting together your teams and for keeping tennis in North Jeffco thriving!

We also want to remind all NJTC captains and players about a few club rules as well as USTA rules:

1. To **be good ambassadors of NJTC by communicating with all visiting teams** early (a week in advance) to let them know where to meet and what the water and restroom situation are at the site you will be playing your match(es). It is always helpful to let the visiting team know where they can stop to use the restroom and get water prior to their arrival to the courts.
2. Matches using **Satellite Courts**, please be sure to review the Satellite Key Procedures in advance so you are sure to have a key available to you on the day of your match and be sure to return the key as directed. Captains should have received this information from the League Coordinators.
3. Please **record your scores on-line** as soon as possible. Should you need to reschedule a match, teams will need to make-up a match within a week of the match. Should a match not be made up within the week, you will need to contact CTA to discuss an alternative. Should alternative arrangements not be met, it will result in a double default.
4. Please contact Jan or Susan (NJTC League Coordinators) about **any league issue** PRIOR to contacting CTA directly. (USTA Adult: call Jan – All other leagues: call Susan)
5. Remember that alcohol can ONLY be consumed at the Arvada Tennis Center, as an agreement has been made with the City. **Alcohol CANNOT be consumed on school grounds or in the public parks.**

City Tennis Court Resurfacing this Year!

Twenty-eight city tennis courts will be resurfaced this year as the result of a sustained effort by the City's Parks Department to accumulate the needed funds to accomplish this much-needed task.

According to Harry Johnson, Arvada Parks Department, the city is contracting to renovate the following 28 courts, beginning as early as mid-May, in the order listed:

- Majestic View, west of Carr St. on 72nd - 4 courts
- Alice Sweet Thomas, 80th and Simms - 4 courts
- Meadowlake, 62nd and Yank Way - 2 courts
- Moon Gulch, 72nd and Deframe - 2 courts
- Tennyson Knolls, 62nd and Tennyson - 2 courts
- Homestead, 5700 W. 63rd - 2 courts
- Danny Kendricks West, west of Ward Road at 69th - 2 courts
- Rainbow, 84th and Club Crest Dr. - 2 courts
- West Woods, 71st and Quaker - 2 courts
- Columbine, 53rd and Marshall - 2 courts
- Thundercloud, 7200 Hackberry Road - 2 courts
- Lake Arbor, 7451 W. 83rd Way - 2 courts

The contractor has 120 days, weather permitting, to complete the job, so by the end of August we should be able to play on almost any city-owned courts. The summer disruption will certainly pay off in the long run.

I have just completed a 3-year term on the Arvada Parks Advisory Committee (APAC) which gave me great insight into the wonderful work done and challenges faced by the city in building and maintaining the great park and trail system we enjoy. I encourage any Arvada citizen interested in learning more and advocating for our parks, trails and tennis courts, to apply to the city council for appointment to this board. You might take a minute to send a "thank you" to city council for approving this contract and let them know how many active tennis players we have in the city.
